In June 2013, the Supreme Court's *Shelby County v. Holder* decision gutted the Voting Rights Act, taking away one of our most powerful tools to fight racial discrimination in voting. Now, states and localities are passing laws that make it harder for people to vote, particularly people of color.

We can't let this be the new normal. Congress has to do its job and act.

Let's celebrate the 50th birthday of the VRA by forcing Congress to fix the *Shelby* decision. We can't let the few who dispute the reality of voting discrimination stop the majority from having their voting rights restored. Get it done, Congress. Hold a hearing. Get the legislative process underway and pass the Voting Rights Advancement Act (S 1659 / HR 2867).
